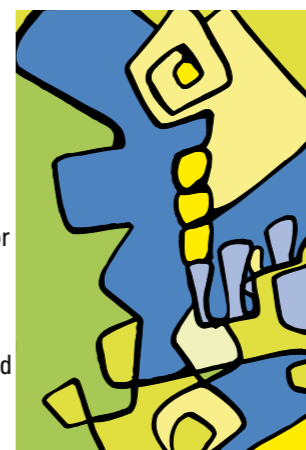
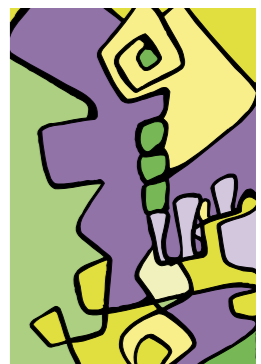

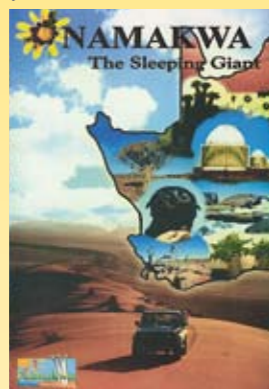
Discovering the West Coast (DVD)..... R80,00

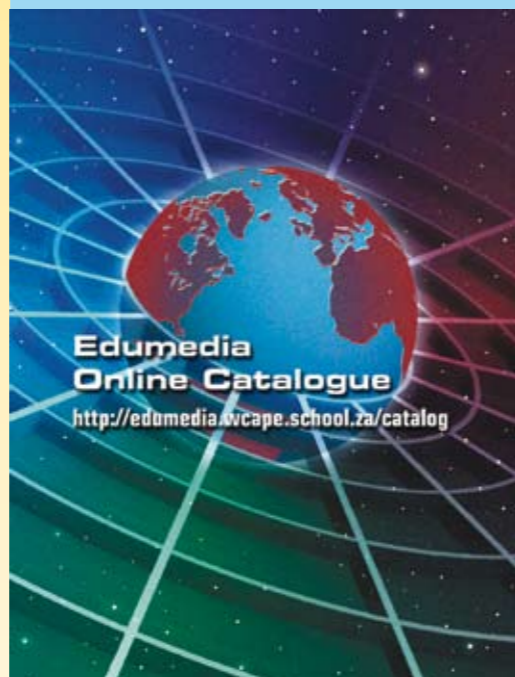

Eurythmy is an art of movement that addresses the learner holistically. Here the head, with its capacity to think, the middle heart-area, with its capacity to feel, and the limbs, with their capacity to act, are brought together as the child responds to the music and poetry. This whole-mind experiential learning intervention can be utilised for neuro-typical learners, as well as for learners with learning impairments. It's this inclusive approach which is demonstrated in the *Moving Together* programme where learners from Vera School for Learners with Autism and Groote Schuur Primary School mainstream learners demonstrate a variety of Eurythmy exercises.

The *Moving Together* package comprises a DVD with 3 short video programmes: an introduction on Eurythmy and the benefits

experienced by teachers and learners, case studies that provide evidence of the benefits and a demonstration of 12 Eurythmy exercises; these exercises are described in the Teacher's Guide, and the CD has the piano music for the exercises.

A story about the joy pets bring us and why responsible pet ownership/guardianship includes sterilization.

It is recommended for Grades R and 1. The kit is designed so that the teacher plays the game too – helping the children to play their part, as suggested in a Sample Story supplied with the kit.
